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About the project

The ASEAN Network for Green Entrepreneurship and Leadership (ANGEL) is co-funded with the ERASMUS+ programme of the European Union (Capacity Building in the field of Higher Education). The ANGEL project is a convergence of ASEAN partner institutions' responses to the strong need for capacity-building while confronting challenges of environmental degradation. In addition, ANGEL aims to support graduates as well as disadvantaged groups to attain a decent income which is derived from quality employment and enhanced entrepreneurial-leadership skills. Another goal is to help improve inclusiveness, because gender and other demographic divides exist and derail wealth creation across the ASEAN nations.

The mission of ANGEL is to engender impact and transformation for two major target stakeholders of each partner institution in Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Vietnam, and Malaysia. The first target group is the internal stakeholders, namely students, academic and non-academic staff, and top management. Within the context of Southeast Asian institutions, the green entrepreneurial mindset and transformational leadership skills and competencies are still new concepts and less implemented.

The second target group of ANGEL are the disadvantaged groups within societies in Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Vietnam and Malaysia. This includes women and minorities, poor income groups in both urban and rural communities as well as people with disabilities (PWD).

Introduction

A strong network for green entrepreneurship and transformational leadership can act as a catalyst for sustainable transformation as well as innovation and development. In order to address the ingrained problems and challenges of poverty, low-quality jobs in the informal sector, the digital divide, and leadership gaps, ANGEL seeks to develop the capacity required in twelve ASEAN Universities. Particularly, ANGEL aims to balance the high potential economic growth and innovation in the partner countries with those countries' lack of capabilities in green entrepreneurship.

One of ANGEL's objectives is to build a high-caliber network of future green entrepreneurial leaders with an effective and efficient style of management who could uphold ethics and good governance while being able to connect with the local/regional and international market





ecosystem with a multiplier effect in the ASEAN region. Amongst others, the project is fostering engagement, exchange, and sharing because of the establishment of the ANGEL Innovative Units and Hubs. Precisely, through the Unit, a university network will reach and mobilize both internal and external stakeholders. Simultaneously, the Hub ensures exchange and sharing principles as they are centres of early-stage startup development in green technologies, energy, and sustainable development along with the communities created by each University.

During the WP2 - Setting up the ANGEL Ecosystem, one **ANGEL Innovative Unit** was established in each HEI partner. Their operation is based upon the knowledge transferred to the ANGEL Enterprise teams that were formed and stormed during the WP1 - Customization and Training. The mission of the ANGEL Innovate Units is **to sustain and advance ANGEL project in the long term** through a) the support of entrepreneurial learning, b) partnership-building with intra and extra University actors, and c) the development of expertise in the commercialization of Universities' knowledge and technology.

Correspondingly, one **ANGEL Hub** was established in each ASEAN partner University. They are centres for technology entrepreneurship development, joint ventures for the development of early-stage startups in green technologies, energy, and natural sciences, ICT, and engineering. The Hubs offer a minimum of five workspaces and space for sharing, joint work, events, and expert workshops. They will be used by faculty staff, researchers, and students, focusing on green technologies, energy, and sustainable development.

The primary objective of this report is to furnish scholarly perspectives on the Innovation Units and Hubs of various universities. Specifically, it aims to present in-depth and comprehensive insights into the organizational structure of these Units as integral university services. Conclusion

The ANGEL project facilitated the establishment of **12 ANGEL Innovative Units and Hubs** across **five ASEAN countries**, namely Malaysia, Indonesia, Cambodia, Lao PDR, and Vietnam. Some universities opted to integrate these Units into their existing services, while others established them as independent entities. In total, the Hubs directly engaged 40 academics, researchers, and administrative personnel, with an additional 184 individuals being indirectly involved. It is estimated that at least 300 non-academic individuals (entrepreneurs, policymakers, public administrators, and youth/student representatives) will be assisted by the ANGEL Innovative Units while minimum 120 students will be using the Hub, before the official ending date of the projects. In a long-term period, it is estimated that the 12 Hubs will accommodate and assist more than 12000 students and 60 start-up ideas from ASEAN Universities which is calculated for a period of five years after the project ends.

Each Hub devised its mission, aligning with ANGEL objectives while accounting for unique local contexts. To ensure relevance and responsiveness, a consistent methodology guided the identification of Unit structures and activities, closely considering the needs of both the university and the community. Notably, all participating universities fostered collaborations with internal and external stakeholders, including incubators, unions, faculties, and companies, to bolster their community engagements and enhance the impact of their initiatives.

An emphasis on inclusivity was evident among the universities, as most incorporated dedicated infrastructure and processes to support **marginalized and disadvantaged groups**. These measures encompassed accessible buildings, inclusion support, and complimentary mentoring services, aiming to create a more equitable and supportive environment for all visitors.

In conclusion, the ANGEL project successfully established 12 ANGEL Innovative Units and Hubs across ASEAN countries, fostering collaboration and community engagement. The Hubs' tailored missions and inclusive initiatives, alongside their partnerships with various stakeholders, underscore the project's commitment to addressing local realities and supporting marginalized groups.
